Dear Parish family,

I hope we can make this an annual celebration on the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. In the past few weeks, the Scouts have painted the fence on E13th Street. Florentine Iron Works have straightened the fences and restored the gate at the Clonfert Center. The metal staircase to the auditorium in the courtyard has been scraped and painted. Part of the stairwell inside the Clonfert entrance has been painted. We have replaced the roof on the Ave O entrance of the school. We have made repairs to the church roof including over the chapel, sacristy and candle room as well as repairs to various leaders on the church roof. The roof has been replaced on the side entrance of the church facing the rectory including over the garbage storage area and the entrance to the sacristy. The angel statue has been placed on the side lawn of the rectory. The front and side doors of the rectory have been painted recently as well. All of these projects are important and expensive. Saint Brendan Vocation Committee!

Bishop DiMarzio has proclaimed a special **YEAR OF VOCATIONS** beginning on **August 4th**, the Feast of Saint John Vianney.

In preparation for this special year, we need to form a Parish Vocations Committee to pray for, promote, identify, and encourage young people to consider a vocation to the priesthood, diaconate, or consecrated life. We need to form a team willing to encourage daily prayer for vocations, make materials available and encourage our young people to ask themselves if they think God might be calling them to a life of service in the church.

God never stops calling, we need to learn to listen...

Throughout the Year of Vocations, our statue of St. John Vianney will be in the chapel as a reminder for all of us to pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and the religious life for our diocese and from our parish.

We now have two icons of St. John Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests at Mass. Each week we will invite someone from the Spanish speaking community and English speaking community to take the icons home and promise to pray for vocations with their family and friends throughout the week. The icons will be returned to the rectory the following Saturday.

Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

En tiempos pasados, cuando los fieles latinoamericanos se enfermaban gravemente se mandaba traer al sacerdote para que le administrara los “santos óleos” o la “extremaunción”. Nadie quería ver a un sacerdote acercarse con los óleos porque significaba que uno estaba por morir.

Gracias a Dios, las reformas del Concilio Vaticano II han regresado al sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos su sentido original. Este sacramento es celebrado para todos los que tengan alguna enfermedad seria, aunque no sea de muerte. El sacramento es para pedir consuelo para el enfermo y si es voluntad de Dios, la salud. Este sacramento no debe ser reservado para preparar al paciente para la muerte.

Santiago, en su carta a los cristianos, nos dice que si uno de nosotros está enfermo que llame al presbítero de la Iglesia para que lo unja con óleo o aceite santo. Y añade que la oración hecha con fe perdonará los pecados del enfermo y lo sanará para que recupere su vida cotidiana. Este sacramento, como todos los sacramentos, son para la vida, tanto la vida cotidiana como la vida eterna.

BAPTISMS:

We celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism twice each month. Baptisms are celebrated in English on the second Saturday of the month. Spanish Baptisms are celebrated on the fourth Saturday of the month. All Baptisms are celebrated at 12 Noon. Arrangements must be made in advance with a member of the Pastoral Staff.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS is a process for adults who wish to be baptized into the Catholic faith. Information about this program, or about reception of First Eucharist and Confirmation for adults, is available at the Rectory.

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance and participation in the Diocesan Pre-Cana Program is required. Offering is \$500 with or without music.

SICK AND HOMEBOUND:

Eucharistic Ministers are available to bring Holy Communion to those unable to come to Mass. In the event of serious illness please request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

PARISH REGISTRATION:

All parishioners are asked to register so that we may know you and provide reference letters when necessary.

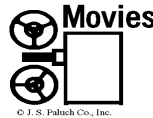


PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
